



Dinosaurs Buried in Mesozoic Strata





First Dinosaur Fossil

- Tooth found in Cuckfield, England
- Discovered in 1820 by Mary Ann Mantell
- Named an Iguanodon by Gideon Mantell after the Iguana in the Caribbean
- "Dinosaur" coined in 1841 by Sir Richard
 Owen











Two Groups based on Hip Design




Behemoth – A Sauropod?

Leviathan – A Sea Monster





Leviathan (Cont.)









Noah's Ark was Huge (Possible design)




Gen 6:14, 15... God said, "Make yourself an ark of gopher wood ... 300 cubits long x 50 cubits wide x 30 cubits high."

"Three stories/decks"




Biblical Ark Of Noah - Scaled 1/192 - (1/16" = 1')




The proposed skylight roof could be opened. This might be the covering when "Noah removed the covering of



Why Seven Pairs of Each Kind of Bird?



How Many Animals on the Ark? (About 500 "kinds" (Families) Today)






3% on the Ark

Gen 8:4 Then the ark rested in the seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat.











Finding the Ark

- Very Difficult to Find
 - Inaccessible location, altitude
 - Treacherous terrain and weather
 - Politically unstable area
 - Hostile native population
- Various credible sightings; eyewitnesses
- Other locations claimed
- God will decide if/when He wants us to definitively find what's left of the Ark

What happened to the Dinosaurs after the Flood?

- Post-flood climate change
 - Volcanism / Ice Age
 - Colder / Less temperate
 - Less vegetation
 - Reduced oxygen
- Conflict with man





Dinosaur Summary

- Created day 6 vs. Evolved 250 to 225 Million yrs ago
- Fossil evidence: 1820 onward; "Dinosaur" in 1841
 - Size varied; rarely complete; soft tissue found
 - Hatched from eggs; young adults on the Ark (80-100)
- Bible: Behemoth, Leviathan (Job 40, 41), "Dragon"
- Dinosaurs with Man
 - Historical accounts Herodotus, Josephus, others
 - Dragon Legends
 - Seen in carvings, drawings, pottery, petroglyphs
- Extinction: Asteroid (65 mya) vs. Noah's Flood, then post-flood climate change and clashes with man

Ark Summary

- Noah, his family and the animals delivered
- Flood Legends on every continent
 - Common theme: People saved in a boat
- Huge, barge-like boat (300 x 50 x 30 cubits)
 - Large enough for animals (3000-6500)
 - Some by pairs, some by seven (or seven pairs)
 - 3 decks and a window at top (ventilation?)
 - Seaworthy
 - One door (type of Jesus Christ)
- A portion of the Ark probably still exists

Take-Aways

- Dinosaurs were created and lived at the same time as mankind (not millions of years ago)
- Dinosaurs are described in the Bible
- The Ark, as described in the Bible, was sufficient for its task
- Dinosaurs were on the Ark
- We can <u>trust the Bible</u>
